The broad, balanced and coherent curriculum at SBL ensures that all of our students are fully engaged in their learning journey and so achieve the best qualifications they can to support progression to post-16 education. Students have five, one-hour

lessons per day and we operate a two week timetable.

Our curriculum is tailored to the individual needs of our students. It is carefully designed and implemented to achieve a balance between academic rigour in the traditional subjects while developing students' spiritual, moral, cultural, social and physical abilities.

ACADEMIC RESULTS

The hard work of our students, combined with the expertise and dedication of staff, has resulted in a fantastic set of GCSE outcomes over the last two years since formal examinations were restarted after the pandemic. In fact, the progress made by our

students from the end of Key Stage 2 to Key Stage 4 has been significantly above the county and national average for 2022 and 2023.
